

Access Rights needed on Vista and Windows 7.

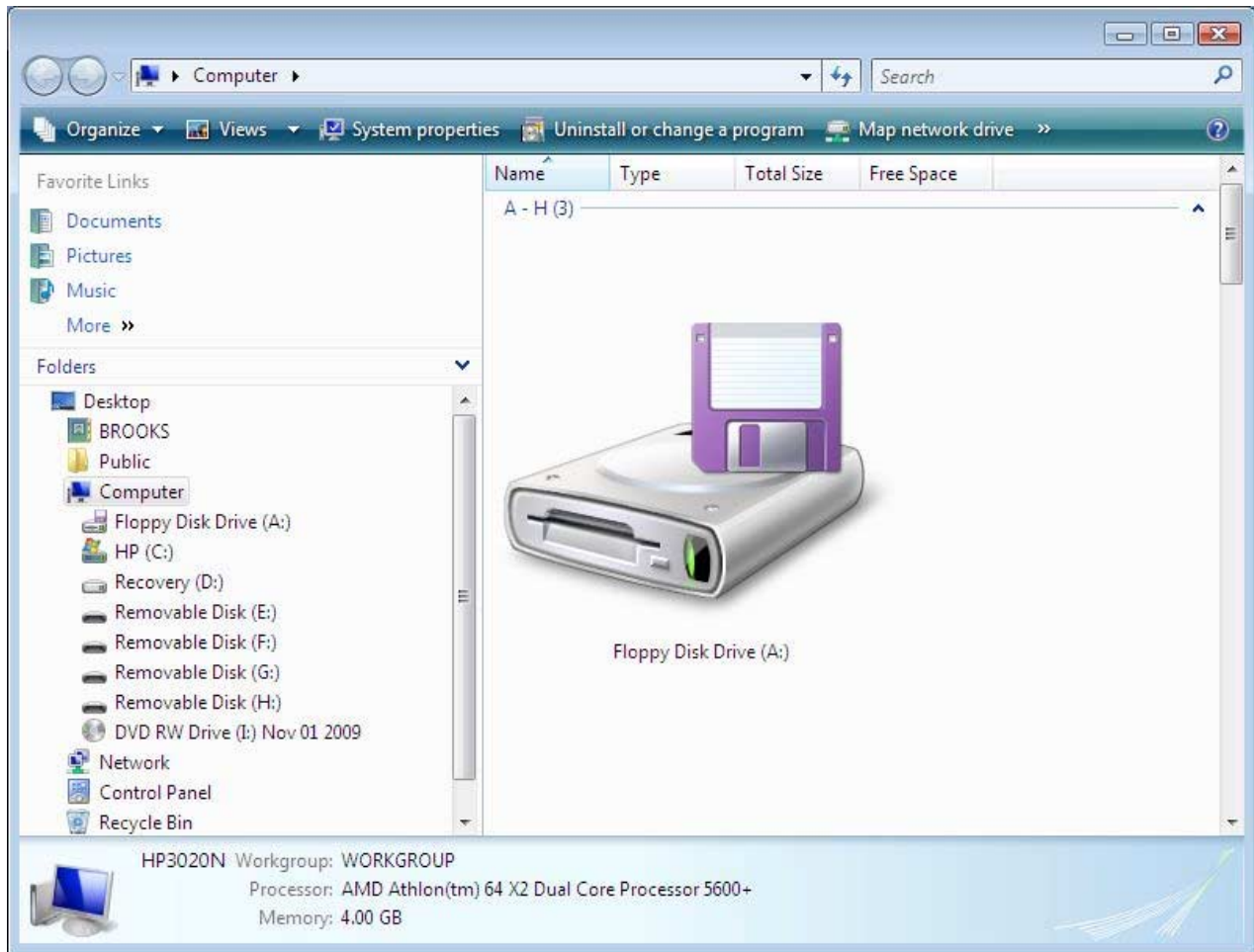
Because of the new security features added to Windows Vista and comes in Windows 7, Modify/Write access Rights must be given to the folder Retain Pro is installed in. Here is are the step by step instructions on how to do that on Windows Vista. If you have Windows 7, the method should be very similar.

Step 1: Open Windows Explorer. Locate the Windows Key, it is usually found between the Control (Ctrl) key and the ALT key:

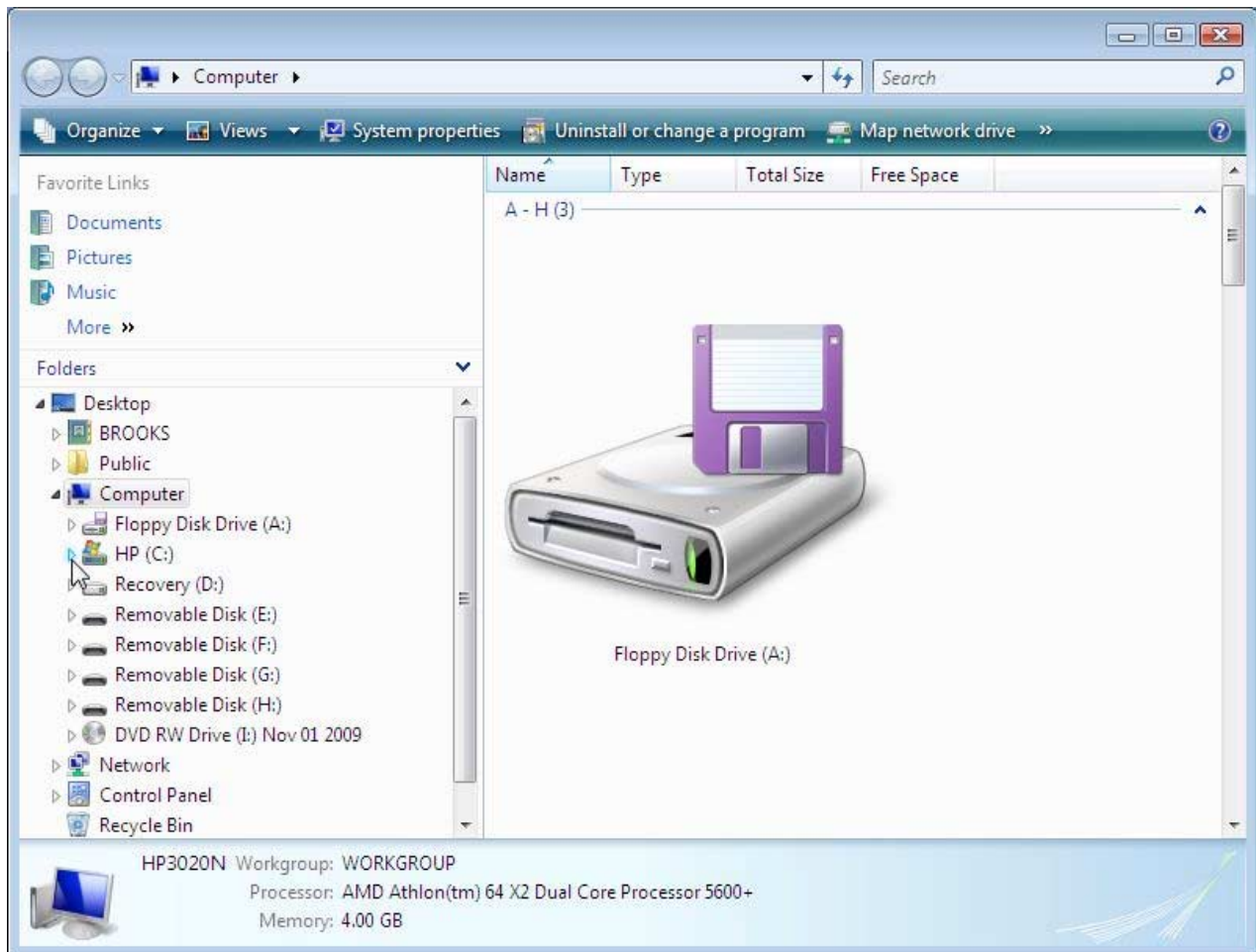


Use it like the Shift key, Hold down the Windows Key, tap the "E" key and immediately release both.

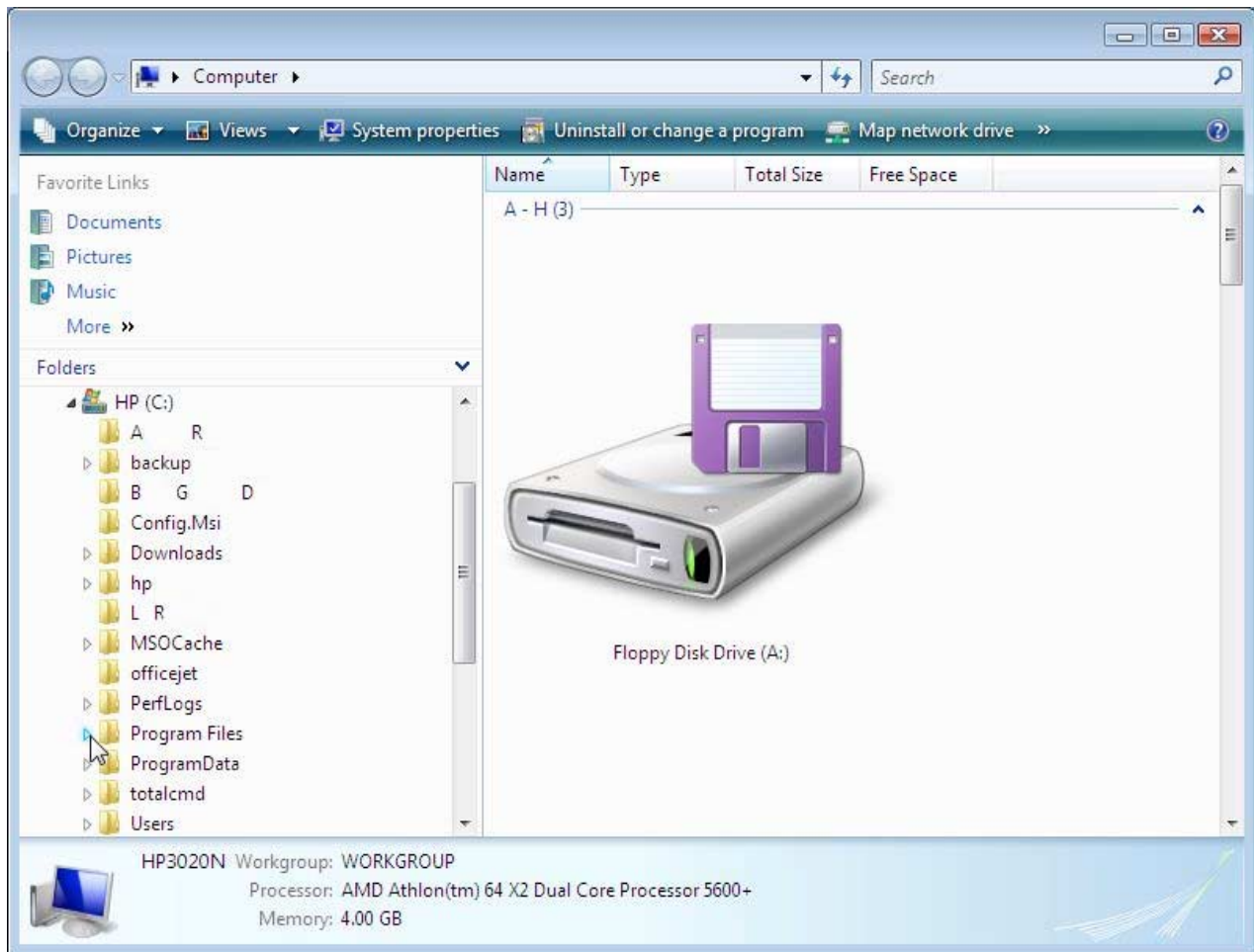
A window similar to the following should open:



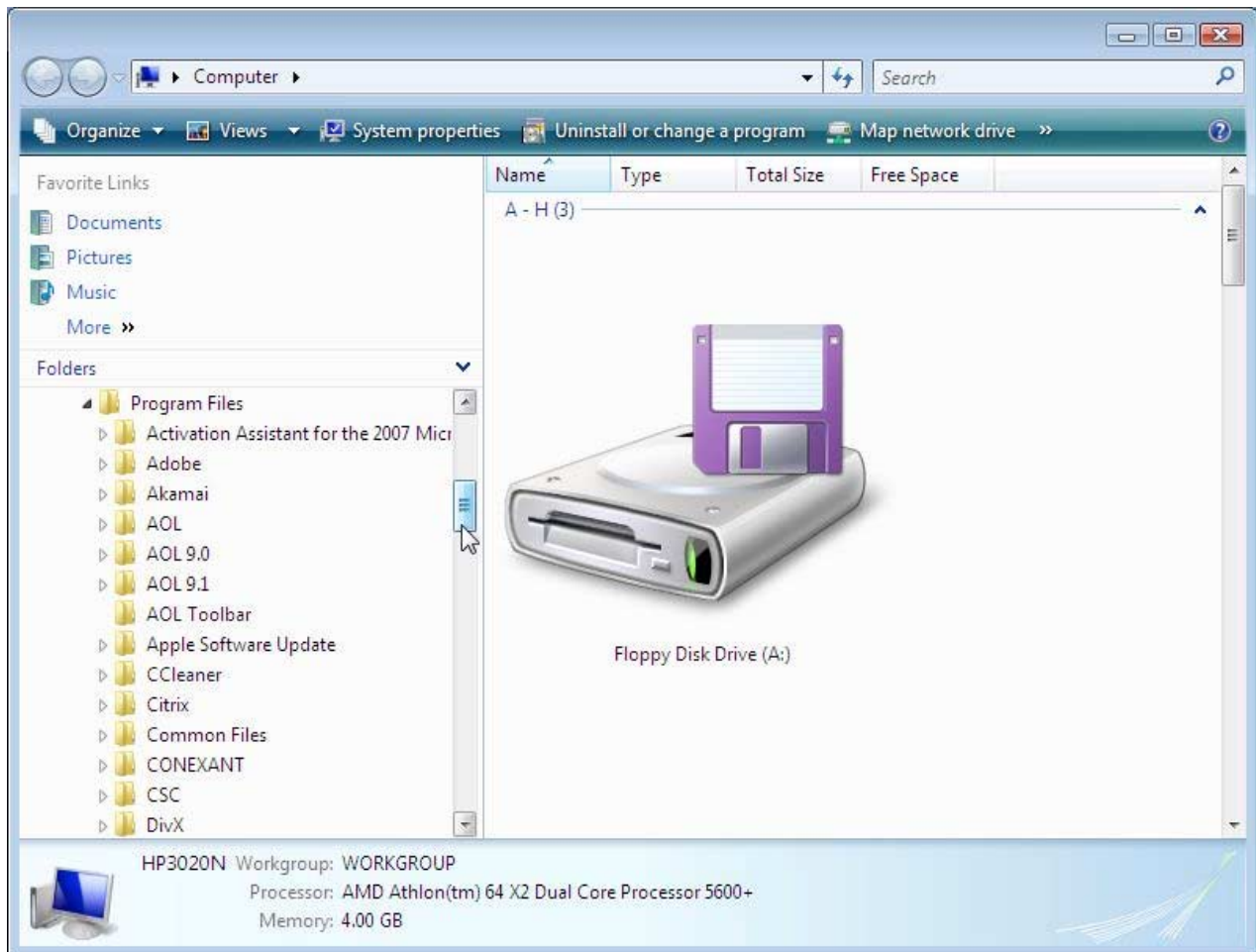
Step 2: Using your mouse, put the cursor over the arrow just to the left of the "C" drive as seen in the image below:



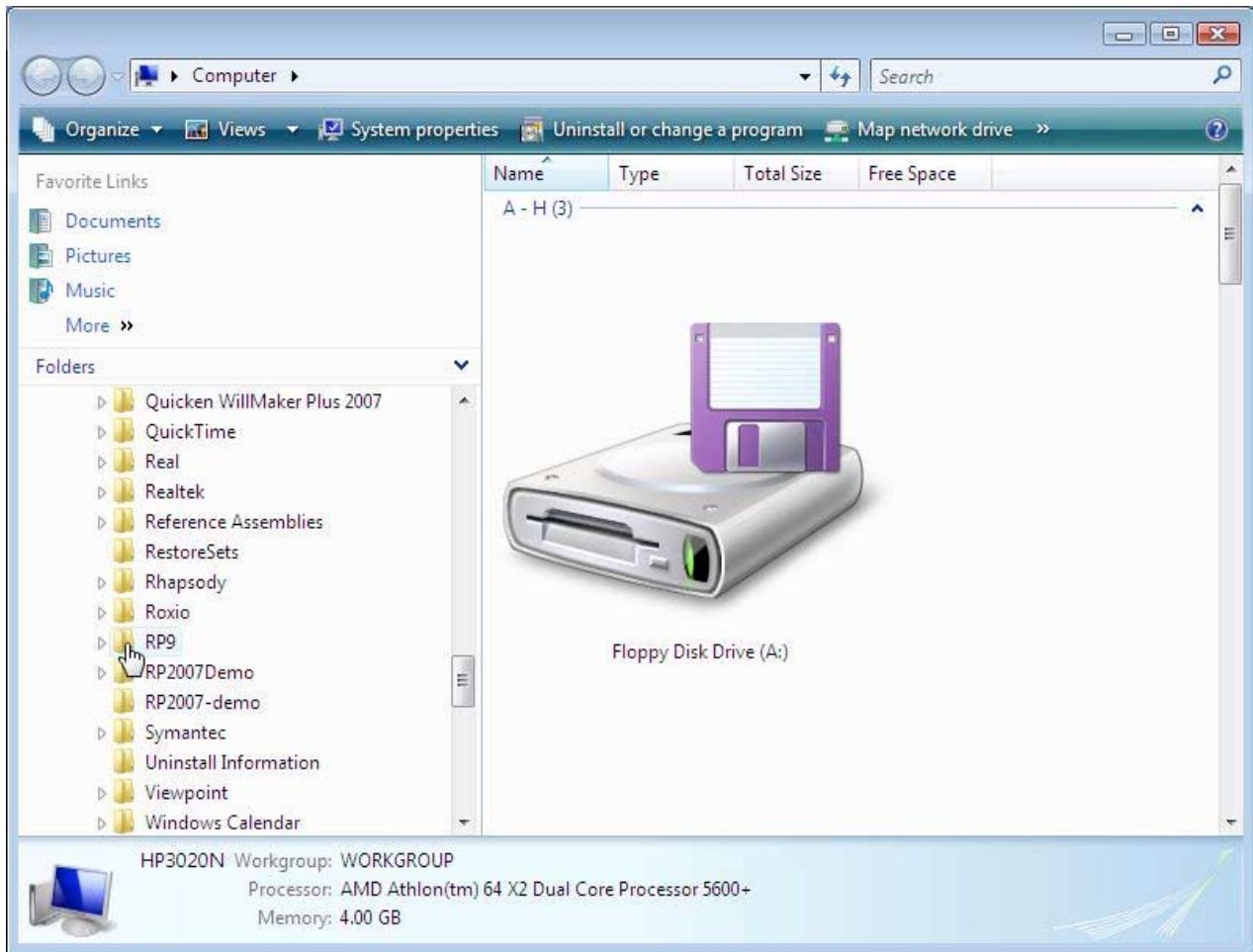
Step 3: Click on that arrow to expand the contents under the "C" drive like so:



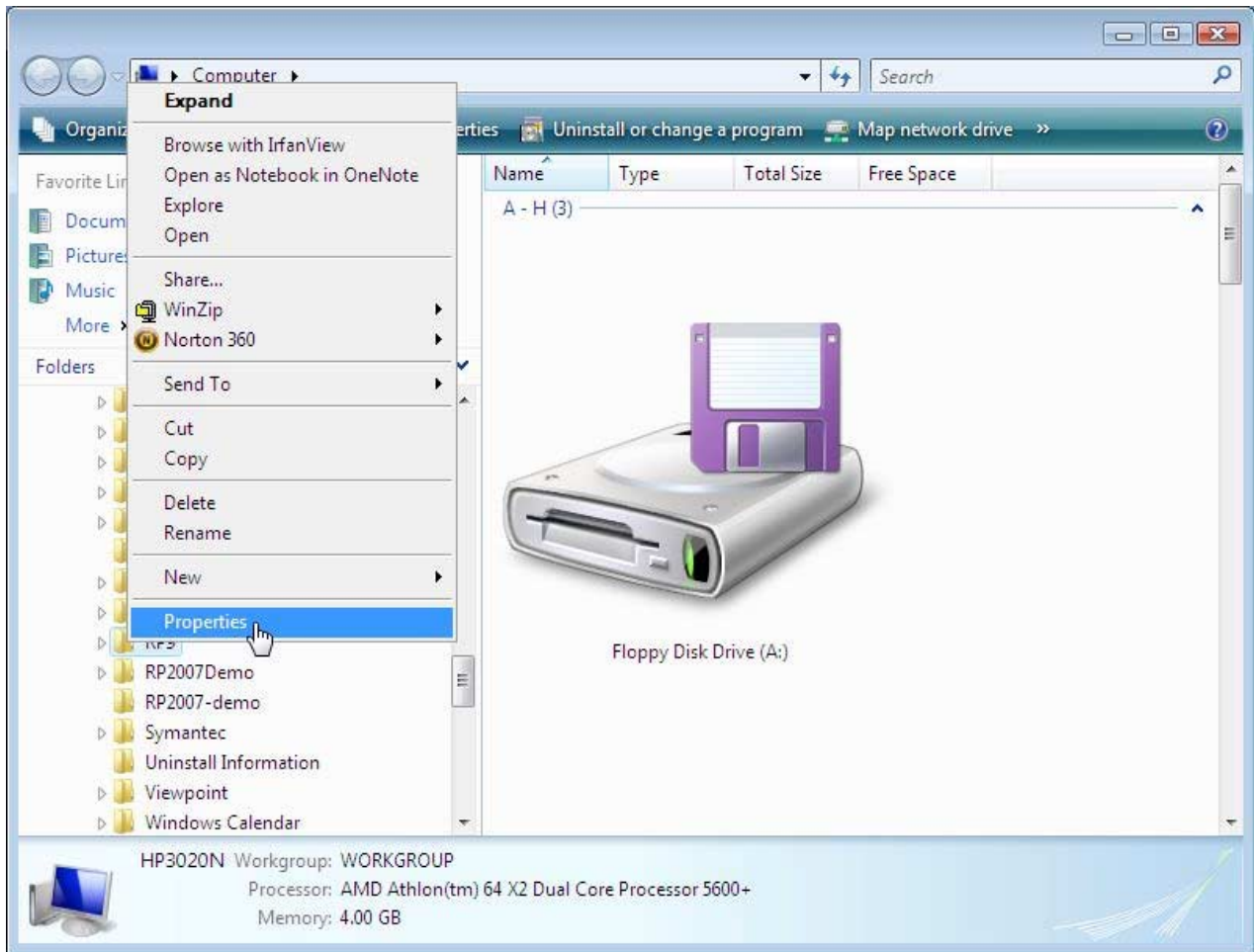
Step 4: Click on the arrow just to the left of the folder "Program Files" to expand it like so:



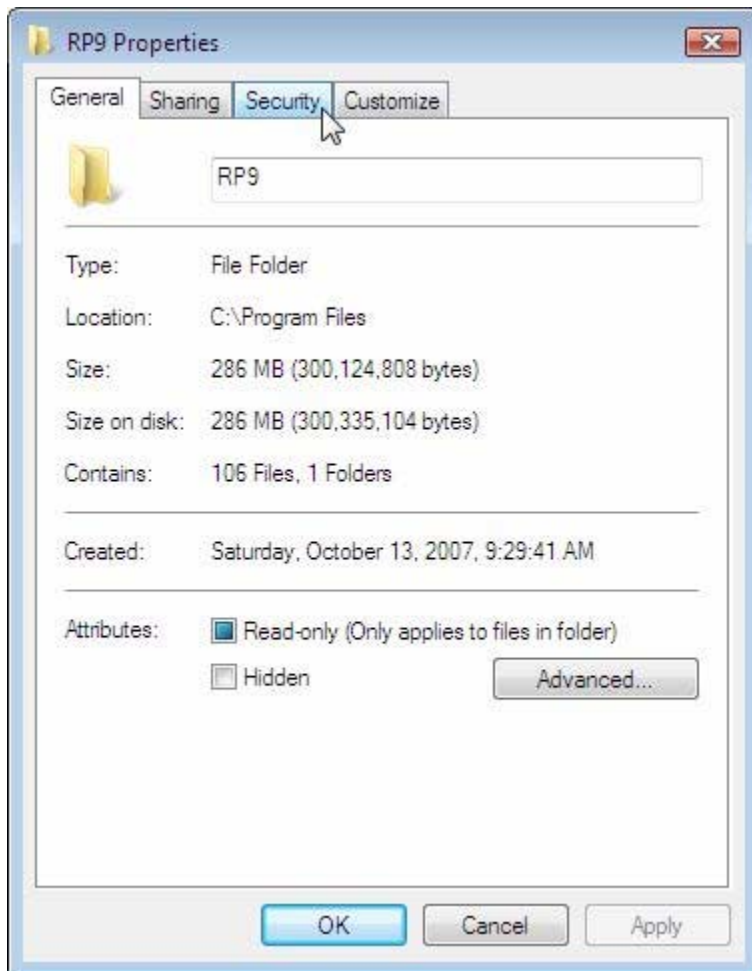
Step 5: Use the scroll bar to scroll down to where the RP9 folder is:



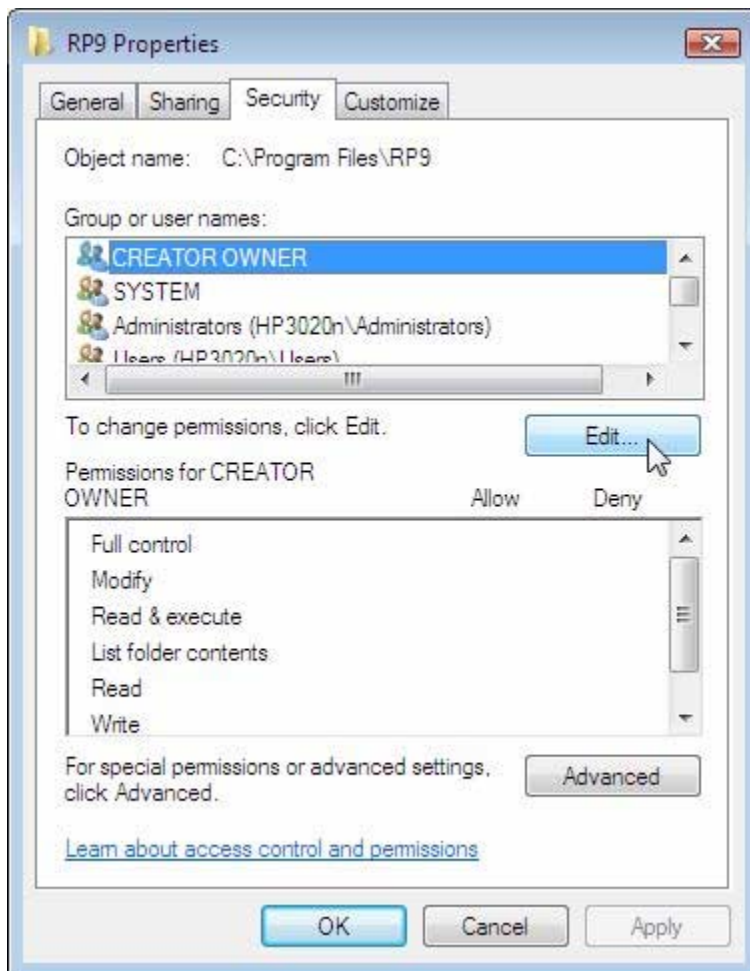
Step 6: Right click on the RP9 folder to bring up the context menu:



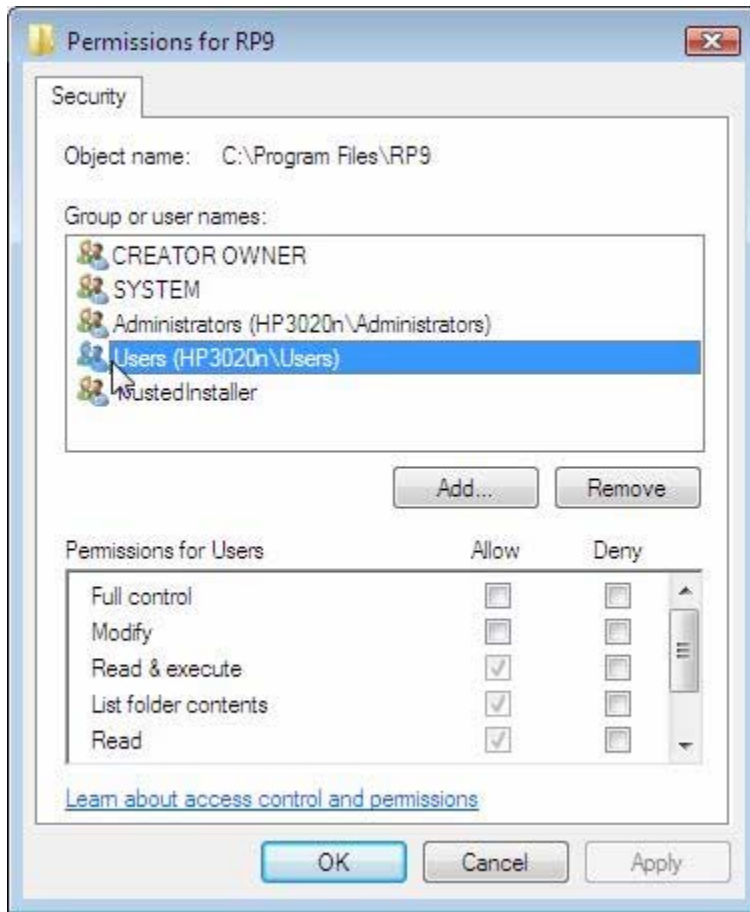
Step 7: Select Properties from the above context menu and click it to open the following window:



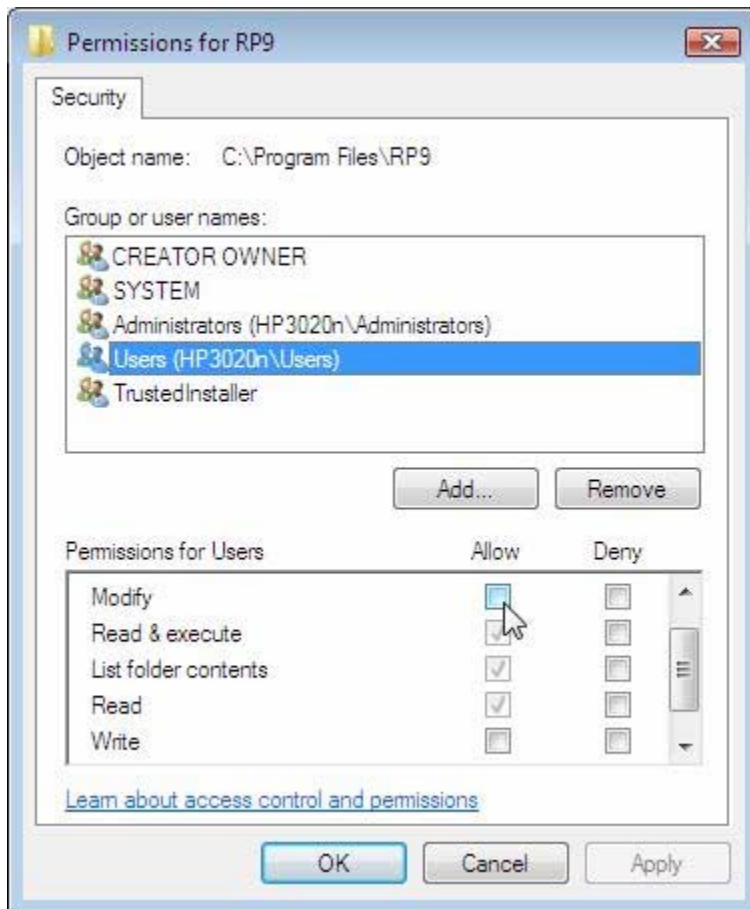
Step 8: Select the Security tab and click it to see the following:



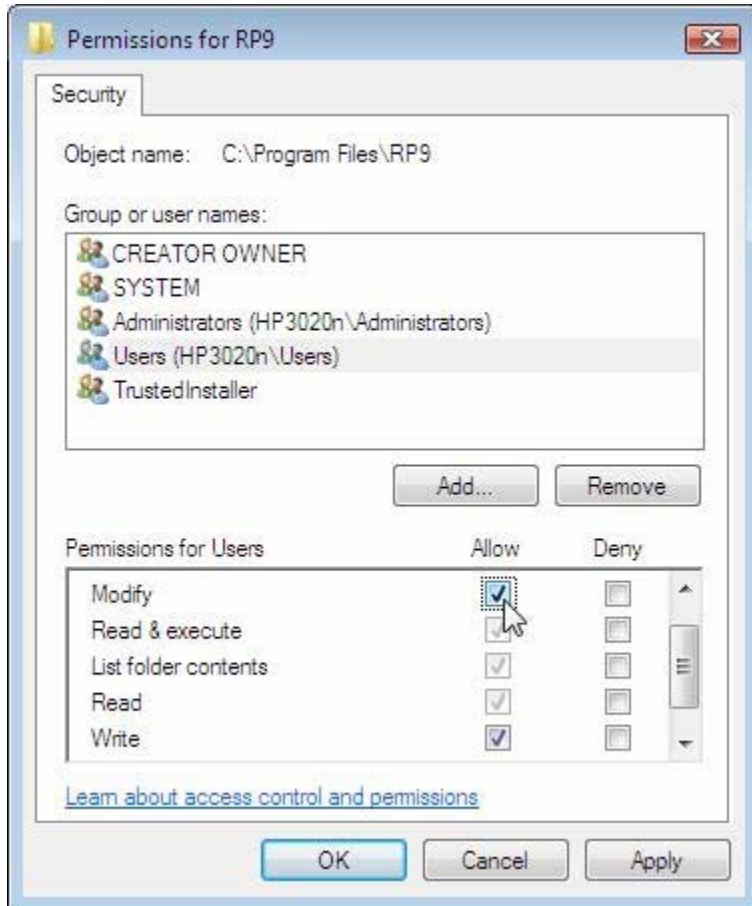
Step 9: Click on the Edit button below the list "Group or user names":



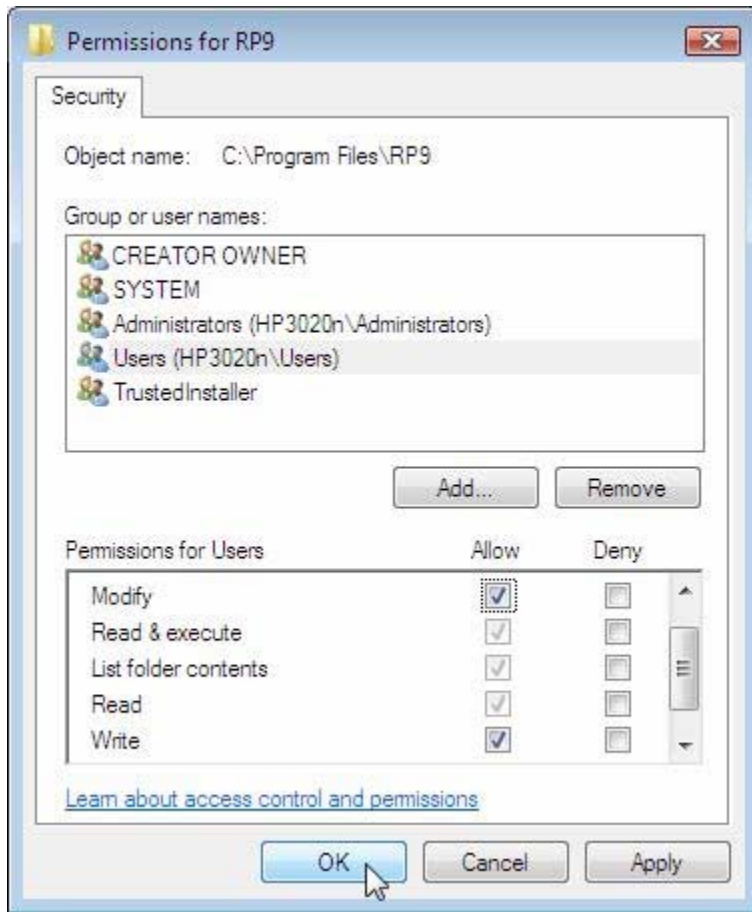
Step 10: Click on the "Users . . ." entry in the list above so the Rights for the selected item appears in the lower list:



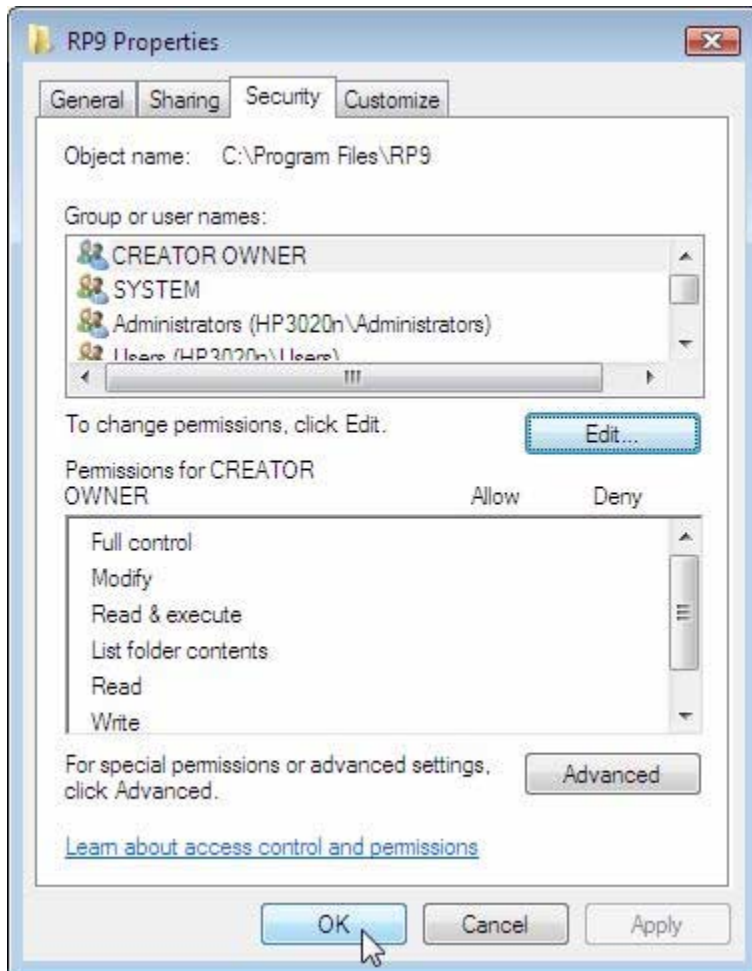
Step 11: In the lower list, click on the check box for "Modify". The check box for "Write" should then automatically be checked, but if not, click on it so that it is checked too:



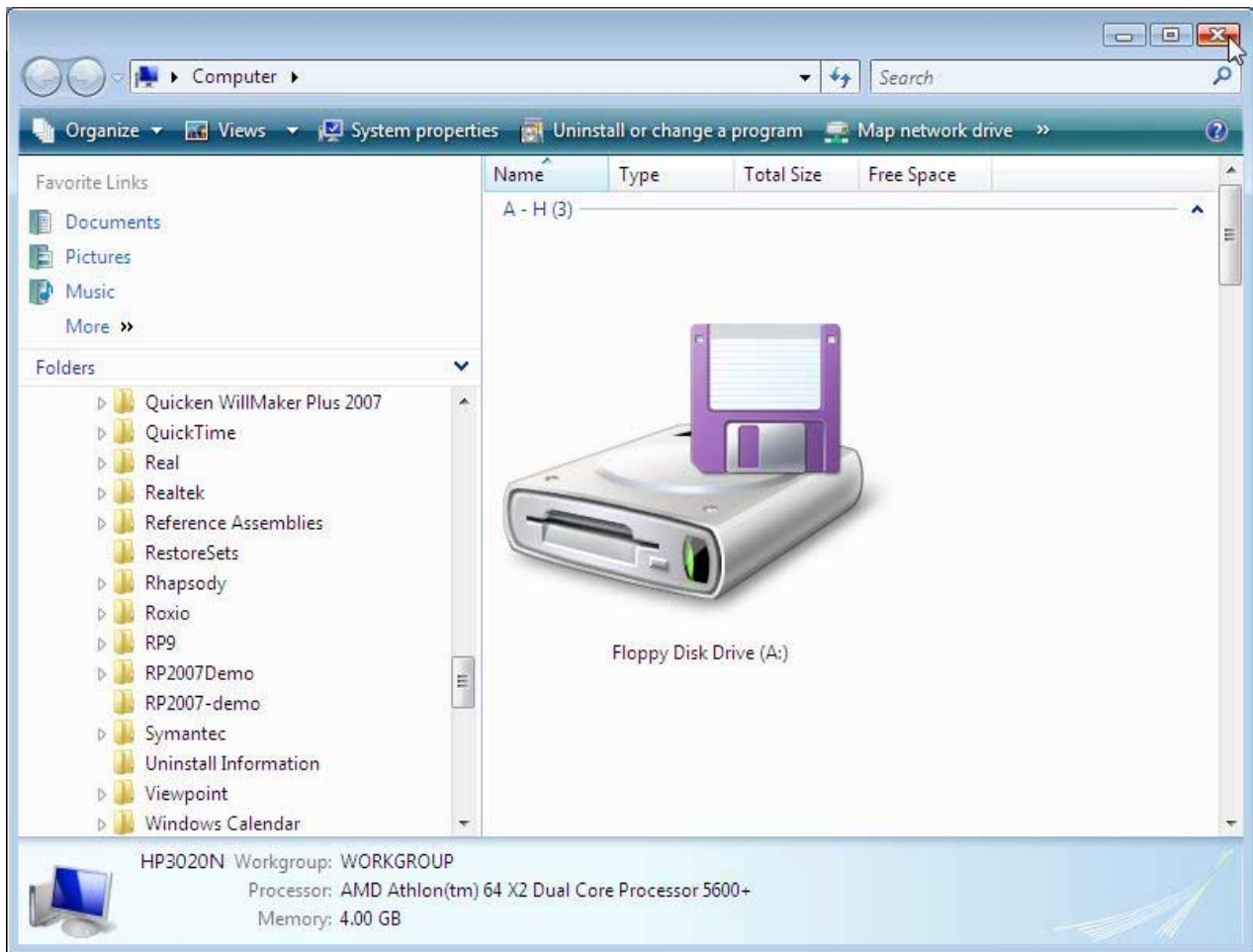
Step 12: Click on the "OK" button below:



Step 13: Click on the "OK" button below:



Step 14: Click on the red button in the top right corner to close Windows Explorer:



Step 15: Close all applications and reboot your computer to ensure that the newly applied access rights take effect.

Retain Pro is now all set to run.
